ACTIVITIES

1. Recreational Respite

Recreational Respite's professionals work one to one with children, youth, adults and older adults who have a disability, struggle with mental health, or face social isolation. Recreational Respite offers unique virtual programs in the form of small group activities, one-on-one programs and BUILD-IT workshops.

They also have a variety of online programs available, including voice tech and show choir classes for children ages 10 and above. 




